



Sacred Space Phase 2 Update – Result of June 9, 2019 Congregation Meeting

At the annual meeting on Sunday, June 9, the Sacred Space Phase 2 project was presented to the congregation for approval. A larger-than-typical turnout of members listened as the project was briefly reviewed and questions were answered.

We are pleased to report that the **proposal passed with 90% approval**. With this approval to proceed, the project team is now turning their attention to three primary activities:

- Working with the architects to create additional drawings for city review and approval;
- Creating a new, more detailed set of 2D renderings and 3D animation for the congregation to review; and
- Planning the fall capital stewardship campaign, which will begin Sunday, September 15, the weekend following the Homecoming Picnic.

Many members of the congregation have been involved in this planning and we appreciate their thoughtful and dedicated work. More volunteers will be needed in the coming months for small and medium tasks. These volunteer activities include prayer support, Bible study planning, worship activities and fellowship gatherings.
