Dear Prospective 2021 Mission Team Students and Parents,

We are very excited that you are interested in applying to join the mission team this year! Despite the challenges of COVID, we are committed to offering students an opportunity to serve in the mission field. With the recent FDA approval of a COVID vaccine, we are encouraged that risks associated with COVID will decrease. However, the mission is only four months away so we must prepare by taking in consideration the current and constantly changing environment.

We have spent countless hours researching best practices and speaking to physicians to learn how best to mitigate risks related to COVID. Our COVID mitigation plan will be finalized closer to the trip but will include considerations such as maximizing the use of outdoor spaces, monitoring students' symptoms, wearing face coverings when appropriate, and sanitizing commonly used surfaces. The health and safety of our students is paramount.

We will be able to better mitigate risks by having a domestic trip. We will be driving to our destination so we will not have to go to an airport or fly on a plane. Students will be less likely to be near large groups of people.

We understand that it is difficult to make a firm commitment to a mission trip given the current circumstances, but we ask you to spend several days as a family to think it over and prayerfully consider what is best for your student and your family. Parents are just as much team members as the students.

This is an advanced mission trip. We are going to wholeheartedly serve wherever God places us in North Carolina. During the preparation of the trip, and during our service on the actual trip itself, we will focus on immersing ourselves in the Word, making our faith lives a priority, being the light of the world, and being the salt of the earth. We pray that God will continue to use us as His servants when we return home.

Team Size - We are anticipating a smaller group this year but will cap the size at 25 students. Adult mentor/chaperones will be commensurate with the number of students.

Time Commitment - This mission (the prep and the actual traveling) is a <u>BIG</u> time commitment- but well worth it. We understand that homework takes *a lot* of time, that sports schedules aren't given in advance, and that there are many other activities that take up your time. Please understand that if you decide to apply and possibly be part of this team, you will also need to <u>make time</u> to properly prepare yourself for this mission with the team. This includes Sunday afternoon meetings, day team work time, and regular youth group.

Team Meetings - The full team meeting dates/times that are included in this application are mandatory for students. It is extremely important to attend all meetings in order to get all of the information and to be able to collaborate with your teammates. Students will be given the opportunity to attend any meeting virtually if they feel sick, have been in contact with someone with COVID, or are waiting for COVID test results. Students should never feel they need to compromise their health just to attend a meeting in person. Students will be required to wear masks during all team meetings and small group work sessions.

Please give this entire application, including the typed portion, to us in <u>hard copy form</u>. Please <u>do not</u> send this application, or parts of this application, via email or electronically. **This application is due to us on or before Sunday, January 24 2021 by 7 PM.**

This year more than ever, please do not hesitate to talk with us about anything that you might need. Communication is key! We would love to have a dialogue with you (both students and parents!) regarding ideas and concerns. Feel free to call, text or email. We are here to support your family. It is better to apply even if you have concerns, and schedule a time to talk with us, rather than not to apply at all. We cannot accept late application under any circumstances! We have released this application three weeks before the due date so you will have ample time to talk as a family and with us, if need be.

Prayerfully consider this application. Think about how God might use you through this unique opportunity. We are praying for you as well.
