Christian, Lutheran, LCMS and Redeemer History 100 Years Written by Ginny Schalm

- **6 Sep 1924** Birmingham, MI USA This is the day that **Rev. Luther August Schuessler** started his LCMS call to canvas the Birmingham, MI USA area to see if a Lutheran church should be started here. He graduated from Concordia Theological Seminary, St Louis, MO USA in 1923, and after a year of post-grad work, He was ordained 13 Jul 1924.
- **23 Nov 1924** Birmingham, MI USA First service held in Johnston-Shaw Hall on the 2nd floor of the Johnston-Shaw Building. This was also the first Lutheran church service in Birmingham, MI USA. **Rev C. H. Ruesskamp** of Detroit conducted the service. **Rev. Luther August Schuessler** was installed as the first Pastor.
- **27 Jan 1925** Johnston-Shaw Hall, Birmingham, MI USA First Redeemer child baptized, **Raymond Leafdale**.
- 29 Mar 1925 Birmingham, MI USA "Redeemer Evangelical Lutheran Church" officially named.
- **Spring 1925** Birmingham, MI USA Congregation organized Part of Lutheran Church/Missouri Synod/English District. Lutheran Women's Missionary League LWML formed
- **10 May 1925** Birmingham, MI USA Ann Street Chapel constructed as a portable building at the Northwest corner of Lincoln and Ann Streets.

 Two special services were held. The **Rev. G. Schuessler** of Chicago, Il., preached the dedicatory sermon. **Rev. A.H. A. Loeber** of Detroit delivered an instructive address on I Corinthians 15, 58.
- **2 Aug 1925** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI **USA Marron Andussi** first child baptized of congregant member.
- **22 Apr 1926** Birmingham, MI USA **Pastor Luther Schuessler** accepts a call to Illinois.
- **Sep 1926** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA **Rev. Roland Emmanuel Scaer** becomes the congregation's second pastor.
- **1926-1930** Birmingham, MI USA Parsonage built on the NE corner of Lincoln and Stanley-496 W. Lincoln, Birmingham, MI USA.

- **Summer 1930** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Redeemer Membership: 39 confirmed members.
- 1931 Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI Rev. Scaer accepts a call to North Carolina.
- **19 Apr 1931** USA **Rev. Theodore George Ludwig Wuggazer**, **Jr.** assumes pastorate. Moves from a parish in Cody, Wyoming USA.
- **3 Jun 1931** Fraser, MI **USA** The marriage of primary school sweethearts **Pastor Ted Wuggazer**, **Jr. and Myrtle Rein** at Saint John Lutheran Church, Fraser, MI USA, where **Pastor Ted Wuggazer**, **Sr.** was Pastor.
- 18 Sep 1934 Pontiac, MI USA Birth of Duane Theodore Wuggazer
- **1931-1937** Birmingham, MI USA Fewer than 50 members, many out of work, struggle with church debt of \$12,000 in the Great Depression.
- **1931-1937** Frankenmuth area, MI USA **Pastor Ted** knocked on the doors of the 'rich farmers' in the German farming areas around Frankenmuth, MI fundraising to help the financially struggling Redeemer congregation.
- **7 Apr 1935** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Old organ sold for \$1.
- **Dec 1935** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society hosts a Christmas Bazaar and a sauerkraut dinner.
- **8 Mar 1936** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA A used organ was bought from Grinnell Brothers for \$25 (\$10 from Sunday School, \$5 each from 3 people).
- 1937 Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA 4 packages of Jello sold for 25 cents to raise \$14 for the Ladies Missionary Society.
- **2 May 1937** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Communion offered the first Sunday of each month. It was celebrated less often before that.
- **30 May 1937** Detroit, MI **USA** Celebration of the Centennial of MI Lutheranism at the Coliseum at 8 Mile and Woodward.
- **7 Jul 1937** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA New church first mentioned in the bulletin.
- **Dec 1937** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society sent a Christmas cheer donation to the inmates at Eloise Mental Hospital. They also hosted a Christmas Bazaar.

- **Early 1938** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Congregation transferred from English District to Michigan District of the Missouri Synod. With this move came more financial assistance.
- **31 Dec 1940** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Redeemer now has 120 confirmed members and has cut the church debt in half.
- 1941 Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Walther League forms at Redeemer.
- **7 Jan 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI **USA** Committee of 5-appointed to navigate locations, formulate and present a plan for a permanent house of worship.
- **4 Feb 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Ratified decision for the youth to join the International Walther League.
- **Feb 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA \$50 approved to have plans drawn up for a colonial style church.
- **Feb-Mar 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI Congregation purchases a 6.25-acre site on West Maple Road for \$5500. Authorization was unanimously approved on 4 Mar 1941.
- **1941** Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society voted to equip the kitchen in the new church. China dishes- service for 120 was purchased for \$168.53. \$970 was approved for carpet in the new church.
- **1 Apr 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA 100 Blue 'new tune' edition hymnals adopted and purchased for 81 cents each.
- **6 May 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI **USA** Mortgage for land for church site, erection and extension of building, not to exceed \$45,000 at no more than 3.5% interest.
- **31 Aug 1941** Birmingham, MI USA Ground broken for new church at 1800 West Maple Road, Birmingham, MI USA.
- **2 Sep 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Plans to sell the organ at the appropriate time for \$200.
- **12 Oct 1941** Birmingham, MI USA Cornerstone laid for **The Lutheran Church of the Redeemer.**
- **8 Dec 1941** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Sale of chapel and lot for \$1800 which was approved by the Michigan District in June 1939.

- **13 Jan 1942** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA **Marjorie Burns** to be the organist until the new church is occupied. Approval for the purchase of lumber to build cupboards and linoleum in the kitchen at the parsonage.
- **3 Feb 1942** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA **Mrs. Copp** is to be the organist and choir director in the new church.
- **3 Mar 1942** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Mother's Day contributions will be given to the Army and Navy collections as authorized by Synod. Easter envelope collections will go into the building fund.
- **5 May 1942** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA **Mrs. Copp** is paid \$2.50 pr week until we are in the new church. The Pastor's \$20 rent for parsonage is being discontinued.
- **2 Jun 1942** Ann St Chapel, Birmingham, MI USA Public exam of Confirmands discontinued. Chapel and lot not yet sold. One offer of \$375 to \$400 for the building alone from the Extension Board of the Reformed Church of Detroit, MI USA. Another offer for the building and the lot for \$500.
- 19 Jun 1942 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA The Lutheran Church of the Redeemer at 1800 W Maple is dedicated. Pastor Ted's Father, Rev. Theodore Henry Wuggazer preached.
- Jun 1942 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School attendance 27.
- **1942** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA When **John Knorr**, a child of Redeemer, died, his parents, **Alvin and Helene Knorr**, donated the chandelier in his honor. The candles were lit for weddings, special events and Christmas Eve.
- **Dec 1942** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society sent Christmas boxes to soldiers.
- 1943 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Pastor Ted's salary was increased from \$37 to \$57 per week.
- **Mar 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA It was asked that the \$900 from the Easter collection envelopes be used for beautifying the church grounds.
- **1 Sep 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Pastor's salary to be \$250 per month with \$5 per week for car expenses.
- **Sep 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Communicant membership 206. Sunday School attendance 110.

- **Sep 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Inter-church bowling league begins with teams from Redeemer and the Baptist, Episcopalian, Presbyterian and Methodist churches.
- **3 Nov 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI **USA** It was decided to discontinue Advent services because of gas shortage, long hours being worked and poor attendance.
- **Dec 1943** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society was able to keep the cost of the Christmas boxes for our soldiers to under \$2 each.
- **18 Apr 1944** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA City of Birmingham was permitted to store voting booths in the church basement.
- **Dec 1944** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society sent Christmas boxes to soldiers, overseas and stateside, and "Coming Home" boxes for our soldiers plus service people at MI airfield.
- **15 Dec 1944** Indianapolis, IN USA **Pastor Roland Scaer** (1897-1944), the second pastor of Redeemer, died.
- **Apr 1945** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Discussion about how to raise \$1500 for a Thank offering
- **Oct 1945-Spring 1946** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Bulletin board (plaque) approved in 1945, built and dedicated in 1946 to the men of Redeemer who served their country faithfully and well in WWII. Redeemer had NO casualties. Thank you, God!
- **Dec 1945** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA This year the Ladies Missionary Society made small jars of jelly for each soldiers' Christmas box.
- **Jan 1946** Birmingham, MI USA Birmingham experiences a population increase. Membership began to increase by 100 new members per year.
- **14 Oct 1946** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA A letter went out to the congregation noting that after 21 years there will no longer be a subsidy from the Mission Board and the church would have to be self-supporting for the first time.
- **Dec 1946** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society hosted a Christmas party.
- **26 Apr 1947** Chicago, IL USA Originally named The German Evangelical Lutheran Synod of Missouri, our Synod's name was shortened to The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod (LCMS) in 1947 on the occasion of the 100th anniversary.
- **5 Sep 1947** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Vaughan Heard appointed choir director. The church withdrew from the Glen Eden Cemetery Association.

- **Dec 1947** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ladies Missionary Society has both Christmas party and Christmas Bazaar. They also packaged Christmas cards to be given away.
- **1 Apr 1948** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Discussion of the development of a city park at the rear of the church property.
- 1949 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Carillon system installed.
- **1949** Africa Lutheran missionaries are sent by the WI Synod to Central Africa.
- **Jun 1951** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI Ground is broken for Youth wing to accommodate Sunday School. First Little League game is played on Redeemer's field.
- **1 Oct 1951** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Mrs. Gassaway** has been the church secretary for a long time without charge. It was voted to pay her \$100 per month.
- **10 Nov 1951** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA A special meeting was called to authorize borrowing \$150,000 for the Sunday School wing.
- **15 Jun 1952** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Youth building is dedicated, a second worship service and Sunday School program is added.
- **Fall 1952** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA First year of Westmaple Nursery School begins with 75 children and 26 on a waiting list. This was the first sponsored day nursery in Birmingham. **Myrtle Wuggazer** is the director.
- **3 Nov 1952** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA The final cost of the Sunday School wing was \$156,869.55.
- **1 Dec 1952** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School enrollment 481. Caretakers to be paid \$115 per month.
- 1953 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Aerial view of the church taken by **Hank Weber** and made into 2000 postcards.
- **May 1953** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Clara E. Knudsen** Memorial Playground is dedicated.
- 18 Jun 1953 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA VBS begins
- **14 Sep 1953** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA New parsonage is considered. Parsonage on Lincoln and Stanley is too old, too cold in the winter and lacking guest quarters.
- **Dec 1953** Birmingham, MI USA For \$35,400, with a 15-year mortgage the new parsonage was purchased at 967 N. Glenhurst Dr., the first street West of the church.

- **17 Jan 1954** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA With the congregation continually growing, congregants were given a card to register for communion, instead of having to call the Pastor to register.
- **1 Nov 1954** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA The church was now called Lutheran Church of the Redeemer.
- 1 Apr 1955 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Decided to install clocks on the belfry.
- **Jun 1955** Birmingham, MI USA Honored **Pastor Ted's** 25th anniversary of his ordination.
- **Fall 1955** Concordia Theological Seminary, St Louis, MO USA **Duane Wuggazer** enters the Seminary.
- **Dec 1955** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Church attendance jumped from 108 in 1942 to 722 in Dec 1955. There were 500 in Sunday School with 1000 communicant members.
- **9 Jan 1956** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Secured an architect to enlarge the church Sanctuary.
- **Sep 1956** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA 543 students in Sunday School with 43 teachers.
- **1956** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Third service added.
- **Jun 1956** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI Paving of driveways and parking lot.
- May 1957 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Basement flooding following hard rains.
- 1957 Birmingham, MI USA During construction to extend the church; services were held at Birmingham High School where both attendance and contributions were low.
- Fall 1957 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Vince and Nancy Kochenderfer become Choir director and organist.
- **13 Dec 1957** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Dedication of new, enlarged Sanctuary.
- **23 Jun 1959** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Ordination of **Rev. Duane Theodore Wuggazer** son of **Theodore and Myrtle Wuggazer** Youth director hired from Valparaiso University for Youth Program.
- **Jun 1961** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA New spire on church is completed.

- **2 Feb 1962** Chicago, IL USA The first Pastor of Redeemer, **Pastor Luther Schuessler** (1900-1962), dies from complications from abdominal surgery.
- 1 May 1962 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Nearly 1,400 communicant members.
- **9 Sep 1962** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI **USA Pastor Ted** hospitalized after taking ill at church. **Rev. Werner Kurtz** (Lutheran World Relief) preached and helped while **Pastor Ted** recovered.
- **12 Nov 1962** Birmingham, MI USA A second parsonage for **Pastor Duane** was purchased at 636 Westbourne, Bloomfield Hills, MI USA.
- **Dec 1962** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Pastor Duane Wuggazer** becomes the first assistant pastor.
- **18 Mar 1963** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Plans to establish School of Religion (SOR).
- **May-Jul 1963** Israel **Pastor Ted and Myrtle Wuggazer** tour Europe and the Holy Land.
- **Jun 1963** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Cupola with clock added to Youth building entrance.
- **Sep 1963** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA School of Religion SOR is organized with 210 enrolled.
- **Fall 1963** Ann Arbor, MI USA Concordia, Ann Arbor opens as a junior college.
- **5 Oct 1963** Cleveland, OH USA Birth of **Randall James Schlak**, later to become the fifth senior pastor of Redeemer.
- **18 May 1964** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA A motion is made to install airconditioning in the church.
- **Dec 1965** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Membership reaches 1500.
- 1965 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **William Beilfuss** accepts the call as full-time youth director.
- **Jul 1965** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Air conditioning installed.
- 25 Jul 1965 Royal Oak, MI USA Mark Wuggazer born to his parents Duane and Mary Kay.

- 1966 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Youth director, **William Beilfuss** leaves, and the position is accepted by **Bill Meinert**. **Bill** was invited to do full time church work with a handshake with **Pastor Ted**.
- **1966** Hong Kong, **China** LCMS starts Hong Kong International School for students in Primary through High School.
- **22 Sep 1966** Birmingham, MI USA **Pastor Ted** (1906-1966) is called to his Heavenly home.
- **18 Oct 1966** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School has nearly 300 each week and SOR 200.
- **Nov 1966** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Rev. Duane T Wuggazer** Pastor Duane is installed as senior pastor.
- 17 Jan 1967 Birmingham, MI USA After the death of **Pastor Ted**, **Mrs. Myrtle Wuggazer** allowed to continue living in the 967 N Glenhurst parsonage.
- **1 May 1967** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA It was decided to leave the spotlights on to curb the problem of teens drinking behind the church. Communicant members 1,557 and 681 in Sunday School.
- **May 1967** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA 75 eighth graders in confirmation class were divided into 5 groups. Both Redeemer pastors, **Bill Meinert** and 2 pastors from the area divided up the instruction.
- **Sep 1967** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Rev. Robert Seizinger** accepts a call to become assistant pastor. A second parsonage purchased on Manchester, Birmingham, MI USA.
- 1 Oct 1967 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Rev. Robert Seizinger is installed.
- Oct 1967 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA New roof installed.
- Jan 1968 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Pastor Seizinger asked to resign.
- Jan 1968 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Vicar Allan Mahnke installed.
- Fall 1968 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Bill Meinert starts training a group of Bethel Bible teachers including Janet Jung, Betty Kelly and Ginny Schalm.
- **9 Dec 1968** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School has 29 teachers and between 250-300 students.
- 20 Jan 1969 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Communicant members 1,655.

- Fall 1968 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Vicar Michael Warner installed.
- **17 Feb 1969** Birmingham, MI USA Approval of the sale of the 636 Westbourne parsonage to **Pastor Duane** on a land contract.
- **Fall 1969** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Gene Guettler** hired as Children's Choir and Crusader Choir director.
- **Jan 1970** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Two-year Bethel Bible Study begins with classes of students studying the entire Bible.
- **29 Jun 1970** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Women allowed at Voter's Assembly for the first time.
- **1 May 1970** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Groundbreaking and dedication for Multipurpose addition which includes the gym, kitchen, parlor, and library.
- **23 Jun 1970** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA A third service in Contemporary music was introduced for the summer months.
- **11 Oct 1970** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Rev. Holger G. Cattau** was installed as Pastor of Visitation.
- 1970 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Pastor Cattau starts the Grand Group.
- **19 Apr 1971** Birmingham, MI USA The parsonage on Manchester, Birmingham, MI USA is sold.
- **22 Nov 1971** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Fencing installed at the back of the property in compliance with a request from the City of Birmingham.
- **10 Jul 1972** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Thursday evening services averaging 35 people.
- **18 Sep 1972** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Weekly Thursday evening services were changed to a once-a-month communion service on Thursday evening.
- 1973 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Stan Kelly** reported that we had pigeons roosting over the west entrance. A month later, he reported that the pigeons had relocated themselves to the Methodist Church across the street.
- **5 Aug 1973** MI USA/Holy Land 20 people leave on a trip to the Holy Land.
- 1973 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Coffee Hour established.

- **Feb 1974** Concordia Theological Seminary, St Louis, MO USA SEMINEX walkout occurs with a split of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod. Lutheran Seminarians and pastors left to form the ELCA.
- 1974-1983 USA Seminex (Seminarians in Exile) Era
- **2 Dec 1974** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Motion to allow women to serve on the church council died for lack of a second.
- **16 Nov 1975** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA 50th Anniversary Celebrations. **Dr. Rev. Paul Maier and Lenore Romney** participated as guest speakers for Sunday's sermon and the Women's Luncheon respectively
- 1975 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School 143, SOR 140, VBS 126.
- Feb 1976 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Acolyte program began.
- **Mar 1976** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Lenten services debut at 1:15 pm and 8 pm on Wednesdays.
- **1976** Springfield, IL/Fort Wayne, IN USA Concordia Theological Seminary in Springfield, IL is moved to Fort Wayne, IN.
- **24 Dec 1976** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA 1,600 attend Christmas Eve services the largest number attending in a single day in the history of the church.
- 1976 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Sunday School 111, SOR 133.
- **1976-1983** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Christmas Eve -- <u>U</u>sher, **Al Schalm** on a tall ladder, puts out the 16 candles of the chandelier. One of the upper arms of the chandelier fell to the floor and shattered.
- **May 1978** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Women included as Board Members and Officers (except for Pastor, Elders, President or VP of Church Council).
- **Sep 1979** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Chapel narthex redone.
- 1979 1980 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Lutheran High Northwest uses facilities for the school year. Church members **Kevin Jones** and **Beth (Schoen) Lanthier** start their church work studies at Concordia, Ann Arbor, MI USA
- **1979** Detroit/Birmingham, MI USA Redeemer adopts a Laotian family from SE Asia (working with St Andrew Redeemer ELCA on 14th St. in Detroit).
- **Dec 1982-1985,1988** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Christmas Musicale and Tea put on by the Women Society.

- 1982 Concordia Seminary, St Louis, MO USA Kevin Jones enters the Seminary.
- 1983 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI **USA Vince and Nancy Kochenderfer** leave Redeemer. **Fred and Dorothy Rohrbach** hired as choir director and organist. **Pastor Cattau** takes Senior Pastorship at Crown of Life in Rochester Hills, MI USA. **Beth (Schoen) Lanthier** goes into full-time church work, accepting a call at Holy Cross Lutheran School, Detroit only the 2nd person from Redeemer to do so.
- **1983** St Louis, MO USA Church member **Steve Smith** enters Concordia Lutheran Seminary.
- **c1983** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Jean Cuthbert** Woman of the Year.
- **1984** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Sue Barry** hired as Handbell director. 'Women of Redeemer' replaces Women's Society. Marge Noettl was hired as Family Life Director.
- **Aug 1984** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA New sound system installed in the Sanctuary.
- 1984 Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA Kitty Sweitzer Woman of the Year.
- **1985** Redeemer, Birmingham, MI USA **Linda Lewis** Woman of the Year from Lutheran High Northwest.
